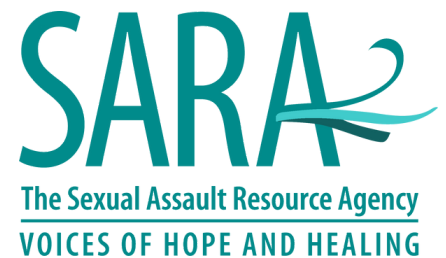
Prevention Services
